‘Expression of Interest’ in one part is invited in prescribed format from **Schools/ Education Trust/Society registered under the Andhra Pradesh State Education Board / CBSE Board (Registration and Regulation of Andhra Pradesh / Central Government) to run a School at UCIL, Tummalapalle, YSR Kadapa District, Andhra Pradesh – 516 349 through MoU, as follows:**

1. The approx. tentative number of present students of UCIL is approx. 410 (from class LKG to 8th standard) which may further increase or decrease. Schools shall have liberty to fill up the vacant seats if any from outside students only after admitting all UCIL students.
2. The successful agency shall have to ensure required qualified teaching and non-teaching staff as per CBSE/State Govt/Central Govt guidelines and has to manage other school affairs.
3. Basic Infrastructure facilities shall be provided by UCIL, as per follows:
 - i) School building facility (Prefab structures with required furniture) including class rooms and other allied facilities like Library facility, Computer lab Facility, Science lab Facility, Facility of sports and other cultural activity as per applicable regulatory requirements.
 - ii) School bus facility for UCIL students.
 - iii) First aid facility.
 - iv) Any other infrastructure/facility necessary to run the school.

Subject: 'Expression of Interest' in one part is invited in prescribed format from Schools/ Education Trust/Society registered under the Andhra Pradesh State Education Board / CBSE Board (Registration and Regulation of Andhra Pradesh / Central Government) to run the School at UCIL, Tummalapalle, YSR Kadapa District, Andhra Pradesh – 516 349 through MoU.

Uranium Corporation of India Limited is a public sector undertaking under administrative control of Department of Atomic Energy, Government of India spreaded over in the state of Jharkhand and Andhra Pradesh. We are having approximately 538 employees working at Tummalapalle unit of YSR Kadapa district, Andhra Pradesh. UCIL indents to empanel School/Education Trust/Society to run its School for providing education about 410 wards of UCIL employees (Class LKG to Class 8th).

A. Pre-Qualifying Criteria: (Technical)

1. The school/Education Trust/Society should have experience of running the regular schools/colleges/education institutes of minimum strength of 600 number students each year from last 5 financials years.
2. The School/Education Trust/Society should have experience of running the school with classes I (one) to 8th standard in all stream i.e., Science, Commerce, Arts etc.
3. The School/Education Trust/Society should have experience of running the school which have minimum student to teacher ratio of 30:1 (As per RTE ACT-2009). The Male to female teachers' ratio must not be less than 1:2 respectively. The Regular Teacher consistency (in percentage) shall not be less than (i) 9-10 years-40%, (ii) 4-5 years-40%, and (iii) 0-2 Years -20%.
4. The School/Education Trust/Society should have experience of running the school registered under "Andhra Pradesh - education act, 1982 (State Board) or Schools affiliated with CBSE Board (Central Board of Secondary Education).

B. Pre-Qualifying Criteria: (Financial)

1. The average annual financial turnover of the Bidder during last (3) three consecutive financial years ending 31st March' 2022 shall not be less than Rs.1.25Cr (Rupees one crore twenty-five Lakhs).

C. Scope of Work:

1. The School/Education Trust/Society shall extend teaching and other allied services on credit basis. The payment will be made within 30 days of receipt of invoice from the agency.
2. The approx. tentative number of present students of UCIL is approx. 410 (from class LKG to 8th standard) which may further increase or decrease. Schools shall have liberty to fill up the vacant seats if any from outside students only after admitting all UCIL students.
3. The successful bidder shall have to provide required qualified teaching and non-teaching staff as per CBSE/State Govt/Central Govt guidelines and has to manage other school affairs. All the expenses towards staff services (like salaries, transportation,

accommodation, etc.) shall be paid by School/Education Trust/Society.

4. Cost towards supply of all consumables for running the school shall be paid and borne by UCIL.
5. Basic Infrastructure facilities shall be provided by UCIL, as per follows:
 - i) School building facility (Prefab structures with required furniture) including class rooms and other allied facilities like Library facility, Computer lab Facility, Science lab Facility, Facility of sports and other cultural activity as per applicable regulatory requirements.
 - ii) School bus facility for UCIL students.
 - iii) First aid facility.
 - iv) Any other infrastructure/facility necessary to run the school.
6. **Tenure of Contract:** The initial tenure of contract shall be for **Three years** (Academic years), from the date of MOU. Thereafter, the contract may be extended for further **Two Years** with same terms and conditions on mutual consent subject to satisfactory performance.
7. The empanelled School/Education Trust/Society shall continue its services till termination of order (Empanelment) by either side.
8. **Validity of rates:** The listed **charges/rates** provided by the School/Education Trust/Society shall be firm and shall be borne by UCIL, which shall be valid for the original tenure of the contract. However, any upward revision during extended period will be decided mutually.
9. The School/Education Trust/Society shall not charge any tuition fees / any other fees from UCIL students. However, UCIL management may recover some amount from the salaries of concerned employees as per the charges paid at other schools of AECS at UCIL.
10. **Arbitration-** Notwithstanding anything contained in this contract, all questions, disputes or differences whatsoever which is not amicably settled as mentioned in Dispute resolution clause, between the parties to the contract, arising out of or relating to the work as per provision of the contract or matter related there to whether during the period of the contract or its failure or after completion of the contract, shall be decided by Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time. Parties shall endeavor to appoint an Arbitrator from a panel of Arbitrators, the names of which shall be provided by both the parties. In the event of failure of appointment of an arbitrator by the parties, the provision contained in Section 11 of Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time shall apply.
11. Prior permission should be obtained by the School/Education Trust/Society from UCIL before admission of any student.

D. Duties and Responsibilities of Empanelled School

1. It shall be the duty and responsibility of the School/Education Trust/Society at all times, to obtain, maintain and sustain the valid registration and high quality and standard of its services and provide education and to have all statutory/mandatory registration/licenses, permits or approvals of the concerned authorities as per the existing laws.
2. Any legal issue arising out of students and their parents under this empanelment will be the responsibility of the empaneled School/Education Trust/Society.

3. **Indemnity-** The empaneled School/Education Trust/Society shall all times indemnify and keep UCIL indemnified against all actions, suits, claims and demands brought or made against it in respect of anything done or purported to be done by School/Education Trust/Society in execution of or in connection with the services under this agreement and against any loss or damage to the UCIL along with (or otherwise), School/Education Trust/Society as a party for anything done or purported to be done in the course of the execution of this agreement. The School/Education Trust/Society will at time abide by job safety measures and other statutory requirements prevalent in India and will keep free and indemnify the UCIL from all demands or responsibilities arising out from accidents or loss of life, the cause or result of which is the school negligence or misconduct. The School/Education Trust/Society will pay all indemnities arising from such incidents without any extra cost to UCIL and will not hold UCIL responsible or obligated. UCIL may at its discretion and shall always be entirely at the cost of School/Education Trust/Society defend such suit, either jointly with the School/Education Trust/Society or singly in case the later chooses not to defend the case.
4. The School/Education Trust/Society will not make any commercial publicity projecting the name of UCIL on other School's Display boards.
5. In case the empaneled School/Education Trust/Society for any reason does not wish to continue on the panel of UCIL, it can apply for exit from the panel only from next session by giving sufficient time i.e., three-month notice. In such case, students already admitted in a School shall continue to be treated as per agreed rates.

E) Payment Terms

1. The School/Education Trust/Society should submit bills within 30 days. Bills should be inclusive of taxes and duties as applicable. For bills raised, final payment shall be claimed to be made by UCIL. No additional payment for such bill shall be paid for any difference found later on. No advance will be paid.
2. UCIL will release the payment within 60 days on receipt of the bills of the School/Education Trust/Society subject to completion of bills in all respect as well as compliance of all terms and conditions of agreement. **Any type of clarification or auditing of related papers of students have to be taken up within 90 days from the date of admission.**
3. The Empaneled School/Education Trust/Society will send hard copies of bills in 3 sets along with necessary supportive documents to the UCIL for payment enclosing therewith copy of the record of attendance of teachers / non-teaching staff, and other documents as applicable shall be submitted by the School/Education Trust/Society, along with the bill.
4. Payment will be made in form of e-payment.
5. Each and every paper/ record, so attached with the bills so meant for UCIL should be signed by the authorized representative of the School/Education Trust/Society.

F) Criteria for De-empanelment

De-empanelment of the School/Education Trust/Society may be done due to any one of the following reasons:

1. Due to unsatisfactory services and proven case of malpractice or misconduct / Administrative negligence.

2. Refusal of timely administrative services to UCIL.
3. Refusal to provide required staff/ services to school at UCIL, Tummalapalle.
4. If any registration or affiliation withdrawn at any stage in any of the empaneled School/Education Trust/Society, under these circumstances that particular School/Education Trust/Society will be de-empanelled.
5. Discrimination against UCIL students.

Note: Once any School/Education Trust/Society is de-empaneled, the Contract with that School/Education Trust/Society shall stand terminated from the date of de-empanelment. Such School/Education Trust/Society will be debarred for empanelment for a period of three year. If the School/Education Trust/Society is black listed, it will be debarred from empanelment for a period of five years.

G) Arbitration

Notwithstanding anything contained in this contract, all questions, disputes or differences whatsoever which is not amicably settled as mentioned in Dispute resolution clause, between the parties to the contract, arising out of or relating to the work as per provision of the contract or matter related there to whether during the period of the contract or its failure or after completion of the contract, shall be decided by Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time. Parties shall endeavor to appoint an Arbitrator from a panel of Arbitrators, the names of which shall be provided by both the parties. In the event of failure of appointment of an arbitrator by the parties, the provision contained in Section 11 of Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time shall apply.

H) Miscellaneous

1. In emergency medical conditions of the student, the School/Education Trust/Society should be prepared emergency treatment and inform reports over the telephone to guardians of children.
2. Nothing under this agreement shall be construed as establishing or creating between the Parties any relationship of Master & Servant or Principle and Agent between the UCIL and Empaneled School/Education Trust/Society.
3. This agreement can be modified/ amended or altered only on written agreement signed by both the parties.
4. The legal jurisdiction of the courts is within the urban agglomeration of **Jamshedpur /Pulivendula**, in case any legal dispute arises on the Arbitration Award.
5. The Tenderer shall not part with any information relating to contract or incidental there to, to third parties except where needed for the performance of the contract with prior consent of UCIL. In such case, the Tenderer shall ensure and obtain similar obligation of confidence from third parties in question.
6. The Tenderer should declare the details of his near relative(s) who are posted / working in any units of UCIL in enclosed format (Attachment-I). Breach of this condition by the party would entail termination of the contract
7. Violation of any of the terms and conditions stipulated above amounts to breach of contract in which case the Security Deposit shall be forfeited and credited absolutely to the Government account.

I) General Terms & Conditions

1. The School/Education Trust/Society willing to express their interests shall have to provide a description of the teachers/ non-teaching staff available as per **Annexure - I**. The School/Education Trust/Society shall have to provide valid/legal supporting documents wherever required.
2. Agreement shall be entered with the successful Tenderer. Tenderer shall quote his rates as per terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the Agreement.
3. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders of such contractors who resort to canvassing are liable for rejection.
4. Tenderer shall intimate the names of qualified persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any employee working in UCIL or any other unit of Department of Atomic Energy. In case of any non-compliance of the above conditions by the Tenderer, their offer is liable for rejection.
5. All corrections shall be attested under the dated initials of the Tenderer
6. Offers having proposals for only part of scope of work shall be rejected. Bidders have to accept the scope of work given in the tender in totality.
7. The General Terms and Conditions of the proposed MOU' shall be as per Annexure - II.
8. All the pages of the documents uploaded by interested bidders should be signed by the Authorised signatory of the school with seal.
9. The prospective Schools shall have to upload a comparative statement of the rates class wise breakup including transportation charges, at which separately indicating the existing signboard rate of the school vis- a-vis the rates at which the school proposes to provide the services to UCIL.
10. Schools expressing interest and fulfilling the Qualifying Criteria shall be shortlisted after on-site physical inspection by authorized officials of UCIL and its representatives.
11. The rates of only the short-listed Schools shall be opened in the presence of the Authorised representatives of the concerned Schools.
12. The shortlisted School/Education Trust/Society may be called for negotiation and finalization of MOU at the discretion of UCIL
13. Mere participation in the EOI does not entitle a participant for entering into MoU with UCIL. UCIL reserves the right to enter into MOU with any one or more Schools at its own discretion without assigning any reasons thereof.

J) Mode of Submission of EOI
