Background

The themes for this year meet are perfectly chosen looking at the present industrial scenario "Proactive Safety Culture and role of technology for enhancement of safety performance & Ergonomics and Stress Management" In line with our national interest for nuclear power programme, Uranium Corporation of India Limited is on expansion mode of its mining and milling activity to cater the need of uranium. Consequently, the theme is very appropriate to get acquainted about unforeseen emergency and use of latest technology to enhance the safety performance in UCIL as well as all the DAE units across India. It is expected that the Meet will facilitate a good platform for mutual interaction among stakeholders for further improvement in industrial and occupational safety scenario in DAE units.

At present UCIL is engaged in mining at Bagjata Mine, Jaduguda Mine, Bhatin Mine, Turamdih Mine, Narwapahar Mine, Banduhurang Open Cast Mine, Mohuldih Mine and ore processing at Jaduguda and Turamdih in Jharkhand and Tummalapalle mine and Mill at Andhra Pradesh. UCIL has also started expansion its mining development work at Rohil Rajasthan and Gogi Uranium Project at Karnataka as well as expansion of its existing mines and other new projects at Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Telangana and Chhattisgarh. The Venue for the meet, "Bhabha Auditorium" is located in the housing complex of Narwapahar mine site which is 15 km from the nearest railway station Jamshedpur.

Nominations

Accommodation

Suitable accommodation shall be arranged in different hotels at Jamshedpur city which is around 15km from meet venue and all the hotels are around 5km from TATANAGAR railway station. The list of hotels and tariffs details is provided in separate page. Delegates are requested to book the accommodation in the hotel individually as per their own eligibility during the assigned period kept for hotel booking. All the delegates should pay the hotel bill directly to the hotel authorities. During the Meet days, vehicle pickup has been arranged from hotel to Meet venue and back.

UCIL have limited guest house facility at its establishment and it is reserved for the invited speaker and guests during the meet so, it shall be unavailable for the delegates during the period of the meet.

Climate condition

The weather at Jamshedpur during the programme period is expected to be cold with day temperature range 8^{0} - 25^{0} C and night temperature as low as 6^{0} - 10^{0} C. Proper warm clothing is advisable. The place of venue is beautiful at this time of the year and is ideal for sightseeing and various tourist activities.

How to reach Jamshedpur

Rail Route: Nearest railway station is Tatanagar at a distance of about 15 km from the Narwapahar Mine. Tatanagar is well connected with all the major cities of India.

By Air Route: Ranchi is the nearby airports of Jamshedpur at a distance of 130 km and Kolkta airport is 270 km respectively. Ranchi is connected with Jamshedpur by NH-33. Kolkata is well connected with Tatanagar (Jamshedpur) by rail through Howrah Railway station (about 250 km). It is advisable to reach Ranchi airport.

Transport (From Ranchi airport/ Jamshedpur railway station to hotel & to venue)

- ➤ Based on advanced information from participant, transport facility from Tatanagar railway station and Ranchi airport to hotel will be provided.
- As the meet venue (Bhabha auditorium, Narwapahar) is about 20 km far from the Jamshedpur city, transportation will be provided from hotel to venue and return back to hotel in a fixed schedule, during the period of meet.

Technical Visit

Technical visit to Narwapahar underground mine is arranged for the participants on the 3rd day (forenoon) of the meet.


