### 7. **Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC**

#### **1. PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA**

Past Experience of Similar Services: The Bidder must have successfully executed / completed at least one single order of 80 % of the Estimated Bid Value or 2 orders each of 50 % of the Estimated Bid Value or 3 orders each of 40 % of the Estimated Bid Value for similar service(s) in last seven (07) years to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company. Copies of contracts / work orders and documentary evidence of successful execution / completion in support of Past Experience of Similar Services along with names, address and contact details of clients shall be uploaded with the bid for verification by the Buyer. (**"Similar work means" - Work contract which includes supplying of manpower**)

- I. The eligibility period shall be within the period of 7 years backwards starting from the last day of month previous to the publication date of BID.
- II. The work experience of the bidder for those works only shall be considered for evaluation purpose, which is completed before the last date of month previous to the one in which the BID has been published on GeM portal. Hence, the works which are incomplete/ ongoing, as on the last date of the month previous to the one in which the BID has been published on GeM Portal, shall not be considered against eligibility.
- III. In case the work is started prior to the eligibility period of 7 (Seven) years (counted backwards starting from the last date of the month previous to publication date of BID) and completed within the said eligibility period of 7 years, then the year of experience of the work within the said



eligibility period shall be only considered against the eligibility.

- 2. GEOGRAPHIC PRESENCE:** Office registration certificate: Registered Office or at least one of the registered Branch Office of the bidder shall be located and registered within the geographical limits i.e East/West Singhbhum & Saraikela Kharsawan districts of Jharkhand State, failing which their bid will not be considered for price bid opening. Documentary evidence must be provided as per the following which satisfies as a proof of having the office establishment. Any other document (except mentioned below) will not be considered for geographical presence. Required documents are as follows:

- a. GSTIN registration or
- b. Udyam /NSIC Certificate.

- 3. Penalty:** The contractor shall maintain daily attendance of 7 no. of workman (6 skilled & 1 un-skilled) in every running month. Failure to maintain daily attendance of 7 no. workman imposition of penalty shall be as follows;

- i. No penalty shall be deducted from monthly running bill when 100% and greater or equal to 90 % of average daily attendance is maintained.
- ii. 2 % shall be deducted from monthly running bill when less than 90% and greater and equal to 75% of average daily attendance is maintained.
- iii. 3 % shall be deducted from monthly running bill when less than 75% and greater or equal to 60 % of average daily attendance is maintained.
- iv. 5 % shall be deducted from monthly running bill when less than 60% of average daily attendance is maintained.

- 4.** Bidder shall submit ESI registration, EPF registration copy, GSTIN copy, PAN copy must be submitted along with the bid.

- 5. Manpower Preference:** The Contractor shall give preferably first preference to the persons who are already working in this contract, than others.

- 6. Security Deposit:** Total amount of Security deposit shall be limited to 10 % of the awarded value of work. Fifty percent of this amount shall have to be deposited as initial security deposit at the time of execution of agreement including the amount deposited as Earnest Money.

- a) Acceptable mode of payment of Initial Security Deposit/ Earnest Money:

- i. For deposit upto Rs. 5,000/- : Demand Draft payable at SBI, Jaduguda/Hartopa.
- ii. For deposit beyond Rs. 5,000/- and up to Rs. 1.00 Lakh: DAC/TDR/FDR etc. from any Schedule Banks duly pledged in favour of UCIL. But in case of Earnest Money of amount more than Rs. 50,000/-, the Tenderer should submit Bank Guarantee issued by Nationalized bank as mentioned in Para 9(a) (iii).
- iii. For deposit beyond Rs. 1.00 Lakhs: Bank Guarantee issued by Scheduled bank of jointly, severally bound with the Contractor to the purchaser for the amount same above. The terms of the said guarantee shall be such as shall be approved by the purchaser and the obtaining of such guarantee and the cost of guarantee to be so entered shall be at the expenses, in all respects, of the Contractor. The said guarantee shall be valid till the expiry of the defect liability period and issue of the final certificate by the Engineer, and with a claim period of Six months beyond its required validity. In addition to the above,

further amount to the extent of the **5%** of awarded value of the work will be deducted from the Running Account bills by way of percentage deductions. Such percentage deduction shall be @ 10% of the running account bills till the full amount of security deposit is realized/retained by the Corporation.

- b) All compensation or other sums of money payable by the Contractor under the terms of this contract or any other contract or any other account whatsoever may be deducted from or paid by sale of a sufficient part of his security deposit or from the interest arising therefrom or from any sums which may be due or become due to the Contractor by the Corporation or any account whatsoever and in the event of his security deposit being reduced by reason of any such deduction or sale as aforesaid, the Contractor shall within fourteen days of receipt of notice of demand from the Engineer-in-charge make good the deficit.
- c) **Refund of Security Deposit:** Initial Security Deposit shall be refunded to the Contractor on the Engineer-in-charge certifying in writing that the work has been completed as per condition 31 hereof etc. On expiry of the Defects liability period (referred to in condition 33 hereof) or after payment of the Final bill payable whichever is later, the Engineer-in-charge shall on request from the Contractor refund to him the remaining portion of the security deposit provided the Engineer-in-charge is satisfied that there is no demand outstanding against the Contractor.

**7. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT:**

Offers should be accompanied by an Earnest Money Deposit of **Rs. 26,626/- (Rupees : Twenty Six thousand Six Hundred and twenty Six Only)** failing which the offer shall be rejected. E.M.D. shall be by way of a demand draft /Banker Cheque drawn on State Bank of India, Jaduguda Branch (code No. 0227) drawn in favour of URANIUM CORPORATION OF INDIA LTD. E.M.D. shall not bear any interest. EMD may also be submitted in the Form of Bank Guarantee as per enclosed format. The offers received from tenderers without EMD shall be summarily rejected except where exemption is provided in the tender.

Bidder seeking for EMD exemption shall submit relevant valid documents as per GeM GTC for Exemption of EMD. EMD is liable to be forfeited if:

- a) The tenderer changes the terms and conditions or prices or withdraw his quotation subsequent to the date of opening.
- b) The tenderer fails to accept the order when placed or fails to commence supplies/works after accepting the order.
- c) In case bidder submits false/fabricated documents.
- d) In case bidder fails to submit security deposit within 30 days of receipt of work/purchase order.

8. Contract may be extended up to 10% of total contract value and time upon satisfactory completion of the work order on mutually agreed based same Terms and Conditions of Work order.

## **9. DISPUTE RESOLUTION MECHANISM AND JURISDICTION:**

### **i) CONCILIATION :**

Notwithstanding anything contained in this contract, any disputes or differences whatsoever, which are to be settled amicably between the parties with their authorized representatives, shall all be resolved through conciliation.

### **ii) MEDIATION :**

Any disputes or differences, which are not settled amicably through conciliation, then either of the parties, may approach for Mediation to settle under Mediation Act, 2023. The procedure is to be followed as prescribed in the Mediation Act, 2023 amended from time to time.

### **iii) AMRCD**

Any disputes or differences between the parties are not settled amicably with conciliation and/or Mediation, then such disputes or differences shall be resolved through Administrative Mechanism for Resolution of CPSEs Disputes (AMRCD). Any disputes or differences relating to interpretation and application of the provisions of commercial contract(s) between Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs)/Port Trusts, inter-se and also between CPSE(s) and Government Department(s) / Organization(s) shall be taken by either party for its resolution through AMRCD.

### **iv) ARBITRATION :**

Any disputes or differences where clause no. iii is not applicable, the parties may go for arbitration as per the provisions of Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 provided the dispute is restricted to less than Rs. 10 Cr. (Ten Crores). This amount is with reference to the **value of the dispute** and not the **value of the contract** which may be much higher. In all other cases, arbitration shall not be a method of dispute resolution arising out of this contract.

### **v) JURISDICTION :**

If the matter is not resolved through above means, the dispute shall be resolved in civil court of law at Jharkhand only.

**10. Additional Documents:** The eligibility be decided strictly based on documents submitted at the time of receipt of tenders. No additional documents be allowed to be submitted after receipt of tenders but there is no bar to seek clarification or authentication of submitted documents. However in case of poor response, with a view to increase the competition, admission of additional documents to meet the PQC may be allowed subject to the condition that

- a) "Poor response" implies when less than three bids are found suitable on the basis of submitted eligible documents as per NIT.
- b) The additional documents should not be issued subsequent to last date of receipt of tender as mentioned in the NIT.
- c) The bidder submitting additional documents has submitted EMD and tender cost as prescribed in NIT.

## **11. PAYMENT OF WAGES :**

- a) All persons engaged for any work under this contract shall be entitled to the minimum wage, provident fund, and leave with wages as provided under various Central and State Government laws at the risk and cost of the contractor.
- b) All the wages are to be paid through bank cheques or electronic transfers into the bank account of the concerned person who is to be engaged by the tenderer. Documentary evidence / account statement shall be enclosed along the RA bills without w

high the payments against the bill shall not be entertained.

- c) The contractor shall prepare the wages sheet for his employees in duplicate, a copy of which shall be regularly submitted to the Officer-in-charge.
- d) In case of any dispute in the matter of payment to the employee of the contractor, the decision of the Officer-in-charge shall be final and binding on the contractor.

#### **12. LEAVE WITH WAGES:**

- a) Persons employed in mines shall be entitled leave with wages as per Chapter VII of Mines Act, 1952.
- b) Persons employed in mill shall be entitled leave with wages as per Chapter VIII of Factories Act, 1952.
- c) Persons employed at any other place shall be entitled leave with wages as per relevant statutory provisions applicable for those places.

#### **13. ESCALATION:**

The Minimum Wages and other Statutory Labour charges shall be paid at prevailing rates notified by Govt. from time to time throughout the contract period, in accordance with Administrative Instructions of UCIL and GeM guidelines, as applicable.
