DISPUTE RESOLUTION MECHANISM AND JURISDICTION:

CONCILIATION:

Notwithstanding anything contained in this contract, any disputes or differences whatsoever, which are to be settled amicably between the parties with their authorized representatives, shall be resolved through c onciliation.

MEDIATION:

Any disputes or differences, which are not settled amicably thrOugh conciliation,then either of the parties, may approach for Mediation to settle under MediationAct, 2023. The procedure is to be followed as prescri bed in the Mediation Act,2023 amended from time to time AMRCD Any disputes or differences between th e parties are not settled amicably with conciliation and/or Mediation, then such disputes or differences shal l be resolved through Administrative Mechanism for Resolution of CPSEs Disputes (AMRCD).

Any disputes or differences relating to interpretation and application of the provisions of commercial contr act(s) between Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSES) / Port Trusts, inter-se and also between CPSE(S) and Government Department(s) / Organization(s) shall be taken by either party for its resolution through A MRCD.

ARBITRATION:

Any disputes or differences where clause no. iii is not applicable, the parties may go for arbitration as per t he provisions of Arbitration & conciliation Act, 1996 provided the disputes is restricted to less than Rs. 10 c r. (Ten Crores). This amount is with reference to the value of the dispute and not the value of the contra ct which may be much higher. In all other cases, arbitration shall not be amethod of dispute resolution arising out of this contract.

JURISDICTION:

If the matter is not resolved through above means, the dispute shall be resolved in civil court of law at Jhar khand only.

Pre-Qualification Criteria:

1. Financial Requirement: Average minimum financial turnover of Rs.value as mentioned in the bid docume nt (i.e 30% total estimated value or more) during last three financial years certified by Chartered Accou ntant

2. JOB AREA-1 UNSKILLED MANPOWER -8 NOS

Sub: Outsourcing 6 nos. unskilled labours for 365 days -Engaging 02 nos. unskilled persons in any shift (i.e. in "A", "B" "C" & "G" shifts including Sunday & holiday) in chemical "B" section, Mill for 365 days

To run (or assist in running) the Pyrolusite grinding mill and Lime Slaker in Reagent plant and washing of carbide sludge on requirement. To clean the spillage in Reagent plant (i.e. Pyrolusite and Lime spillage.), conveyor area of Slaker feeder belt and distributor belt (at the top of the Burnt lime bins) and Lime elevator area. Any type of work in Leaching section (Like sample collection in leaching, cleaning/draining of spillage of slurry in leaching Pachuca and tanks or Pachuca cleaning). To assist mechanical/electrical persons in time of need. Apart from above mentioned works, and to work as a helper in tractor vehicle, miscellaneous works may be assigned by shift -in- charge /engineer-in-charge.

Manpower requirement

02 nos. of unskilled labours in any shift (i.e. "A", "B", "C" & "G") are required including Sundays and holidays. It means 06 nos. of manpower per day including Sundays and holidays Shall be provided by the contractor. This requirement of labors may be rearranged as per plant requirement in different shifts. The contractor shall quote the rate considering the cost of reliever also & no extra payment shall be made on account of reliever.

Sub : 2 nos of unskilled manpower in Section A for 365 days

Operation and cleaning in section-A which includes crushing, grinding, neutral thickener and disc filter are as as they will be allocated to work in the section -A Jaduguda mill as a shortage substitute of Manpower. Clearing the jam in chutes and cleaning the conveyor belt, fine ore bin, clearing the jam in the ground hopper, crusher, scalper, DDS areas, cleaning the foreign material from the magnet and vibrofeeder. Rod sorting and charging, loading the balls in the bucket, shifting the scrap and foreign materials, cleaning the sump pit, removing the discharge materials of mill & material shifting.

Cloth changing in the disc filter house, cleaning below the thickener and also inside, cleaning the disc filter surge tank, reclaim water tank, flocculant tank, overhead sump box, thickener feed box, for the operation of valves and pumps. Made ready the plant for operation after clearing the jam and cleaning the areas. If required they may need to work any areas, and to work as a helper in tractor vehicle and as per the direction of Mill In- charge or shift in-charge/supervisors.

JOB AREA-2 UNSKILLED MANPOWER -10 NOS

Sub: Outsourcing 10 nos. unskilled labours for 365 days (Breaking of big size boulders and charging the broken Fragments through grizzlies inside ground hopper bins)

The job includes the following works:

Daily breaking of big size uranium ore boulders above 300mm x 300mm boulders by hammering to requisite size passing through ground hopper grizzly of having opening 300mm x 300mm. Fragments of boulders broken on the grizzly are to be pushed inside the ground hopper bins along with small size ore coming through dumpers. Spillage cleaning job at Mill house, Crushing plant & ground hopper conical bin area Apart from above mentioned works, and to work as a helper in tractor vehicle, miscellaneous works may be assigned by shift -in-charge /engineer-in-charge.

Manpower Requirement:-

Work shall be done in A,B,C,G, shift in all working days Sunday and holidays as per direction of the Engineer-In-charge. The Contractor will have to engage 04(Four) labours in „A Shift, 04 (Four) labours in „B Shift and 02(Two) labours in „C shift. This requirement of labors may be rearranged as per plant requirement in different shifts. All tools & tackles and PPEs necessary for this work shall be supplied by the contractor. The contractor shall quote the rate considering the cost of reliever also & no extra payment shall be made on account of reliever.

JOB AREA-3 UNSKILLED MANPOWER - 5 NOS

Sub: : Outsourcing 5 nos. unskilled labours for 365 days Replacement of filter cloth and disposal of old filter clothes and other misc.jobs etc. in chemical house for 365 days

Details of jobs for replacement of filter clothes:

The scope under this work involves cutting of nylon strings, removing of caulking rope, removing of old filter clothes, fixing of new filter clothes, fixing nylon string, stringing of nylon string along with shifting of old & replaced filter clothes & nylon strings from jobs to allocation within the plant as per direction of the Engineer-In-Charge or its representatives. Cleaning of spilled slurry around filters, cutting of nylon strings wrapped around repulper, filter trunion and their disposal.

Apart from above mentioned works, and to work as a helper in tractor vehicle miscellaneous works may be assigned by shift-incharge /Engineer-in-charge.

Manpower requirement: The contractor must supply 5 (five) manpower on daily basis for the job on all working days Total no. of working days: 365

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Manpower is mandatory for all the 365 days, about 23 nos of unskilled manpower. Only For 3 paid holidays-- 26th jan, 15th Aug & 2nd oct payment will be made and plus as per the ref letter no:UCIL/DGM(P & IRs)/GEN/2024 dt 07.09.24 (Inclusion of provision of leave with wages if applicable) .

Safety appliances which includes new PPE and new tools & tackles needs to be supplied by the bidder only & it will be reimbursed on submitting the documentary evidence. This is applicable only on the successful execution & completion of work order. If the bidder didn't complete the work completely (1 year), Safety appliances, tools & tackles charges will not be reimbursed or deducted the entirely amount if paid at the during the work execution.

From the first day of work itself contractor needs to provide the new safety appliances, tools & tackles for all the manpower supplied for the mention work. Charges of safety appliances, tools & tackles will be reimbursed on the submission of documentary evidence.

After awarding the work order, a Person needs to be deputed by the contractor for supervision work and they need to be present in the site for 8 hours duty and looks after the safety and day to day activities of the supplied manpower and the deputed person service charge or payments will be in the scope of contractor only. Supervision work will be looked after by the bidder supervisor in the site for daily routine works 8 hours duty after awarding the work order. Manpower may be allotted in any shift with any timings. Manpower should report to the working place on time and they need to work in the site for 8 hours as per their shift duty. If required Manpower maybe called or posted in bulk i.e total manpower in any single shift. Manpower needs to present in their entire duty hours and biometrics punching should be followed for attendance (if available). Necessary reliever/required manpower arrangement should be provided by the bidder to fulfill the shortfall of attendance.

PENALTY WILL BE COMES IN EFFECT FROM THE STARTING DATE OF WORK AS MENTIONED IN THE GEM WORK ORDER.

Once the GeM work order is generated, necessary arrangements to be done by the contractor.

For applying the gate pass the following documents are mandatory:

Timely gate pass renewal should be followed. Timely payment should be made by the bidder to the manpower.

For Bill submission :

Monthly RA bill should be submitted within 10th of the next month. Every month they should submit the RA bill without fail. For the bill submission, documents needs to be submitted within 10th day of the next month after paying the Manpower wages and statutory fees and if not submitted till 10th day, from 11th day onwards if it is required work may be stopped and also it will be marked/counted as absent from the date of work stopped and necessary penalty will be applicable from the date of work stopped.

Total manpower needs to be supplied for this work will be around=8395mandays(365*23).Per month manpower needs to be provided as per GeM it will be around =690 mandays per month(30*23) as per the GeM no of days will be as 30 days for all the 12 month.

6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for attached categories, trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
16. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
17. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers / Service Providers are mandated to ensure compliance with all the applicable laws / acts / rules including but not limited to all Labour Laws such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 etc. Any non-compliance will be treated as breach of contract and Buyer may take suitable actions as per GeM Contract.
