1. Generic

Brief description of the work is as given below:

Non-Destructive test of vital winder components (Evaluation of present condition of the existing winding system) of 400KW double drum winder in Turamdih Mines to fulfil the requirement of Reg. 89 (2) read with DG circular 10/1982 of MMR 1961.

1. Drum Shaft: 01 Nos.
2. Gearbox Shaft: 03 Nos.
3. Gears of winder gear box: 02 Set

7. Complete assembly of counter weight (Dead weight holding) rod with pin & nut: 02 Set.

9. Sheave wheel pulley shaft: 03 nos.
10. Cage / Skip suspension Gear: 02 sets
11. Skip: 02 Nos.
12. Bottom pins of brake posts: 02 Nos.
13. Thrustor brake assembly Etc.

Disclaimer
