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You are requested to submit sealed quotation in duplicate duly signed and stamped under your official seal including Schedule-A (price format) for "**Rewinding of LT motors at R.M. Shop at Turamdih Mill for 5 months**" as per enclosed schedule of jobs.

Turamdih site may be inspected by bidders prior to submission of offer.

Terms and Conditions:

1) **SECURITY DEPOSIT & RETENTION MONEY**

1.1 **SECURITY DEPOSIT**

A. Security deposit (SD) shall be uniformly levied @ 10% of contract value towards satisfactory completion of the order/works as under.

B. SD should be submitted in the form of Demand Draft within 30 days of receipt of Letter of Acceptance or commencement of work at site whichever is earlier to materials department/ EIC/ OIC.

1.2 **RETENTION MONEY**

5% of the bill value is to be retained at the time of making payment towards rectification/defective work/supply made as retention money and be treated as Security Deposit. Therefore, the extent of Security Deposit shall be up to 10% of contract value.

1.3 **REFUND OF SECURITY DEPOSIT & RETENTION MONEY**

EIC/OIC shall recommend release of SD and retention money after compliance by the contractor towards guarantee/warranty/performance guarantee & other related clauses as stipulated in the purchase/work order and on submission of formal claim by supplier/contractor.

1.4 **FORFEITURE OF SD & RETENTION MONEY**

The SD & retention money shall stand forfeited in favour of UCIL, without any further notice to the contractor in the following circumstances:

A. In case of any failure whatsoever on the part of the contractor at any time during performance of his part of the contract including the extended periods of contract, where notice is given and time for rectification allowed.

- B. If the contractor indulges at any time in any subletting/ sub-contracting of any portion of the work without approval of UCIL.
2. **Completion period:** This work shall have to be completed in up to 5 (Five) months of completion period from the date of start of work. Please submit a letter of work commencement in triplicate for onward transmission to competent authority, UCIL.
 3. **Working Hours:** The work shall normally be carried out between 8.00 A.M. to 1.00 P.M. and 2.00 P.M. to 5.00 P.M. on all working days. In case of urgent need of rewinding of motors, the rewinder and helpers shall stay at site even after normal working hours or overnight as per direction of Engineer-in-charge or his representative till the rewinding job is finished. They shall also be deputed at site on holidays and Sundays as and when urgent need arises for rewinding of motors.
 4. The Contractor shall have to take care of materials at your risk at site. UCIL will not be responsible for any theft and loss of material from site due to any cause.
 5. **Scope of Works:**

The contractor shall have to rewind burnt /defective motors as per Price Schedule i.e. Schedule-A as and when required for a contract period of (05) five months from the date of start of the work.


 - i) The job includes dismantling of motors, stripping of motor coil, assembling of motors, testing of rewind motors at R.M. Shop at Turamdih Mill etc. The stripping of motor coil shall be done without heating the motor.
 - ii) The rewind motor shall be delivered within 4 days for motors up to 15 KW and within 5/6 days for motors above 15 KW rating from the date of receipt of motor at R.M. Shop at Turamdih Mill.
 - iii) The contractor will have to maintain record of all the servicing/rewinding and get it countersigned by the representative of UCIL at the end of the month or as per direction of the UCIL representative.
 - iv) Any material or accessory which may not have been specially mentioned but which is necessary or usual for satisfactory and trouble free operation and maintenance/rewinding of the motor shall be furnished with the permission of Engineer in charge.
 - v) Minimum 1 Nos. of skilled rewinder and minimum 2 (two) Nos. of unskilled helpers shall be deputed at site at all times by the contractor for rewinding of motors. However, the number of persons may be increased as per volume of job or for rewinding of special motors as per direction of Engineer-in-Charge or his representative.
 - vi) The Contractor shall provide all necessary Tools and Tackles at no extra cost to its rewinders for motor rewinding job. The job shall be reckoned to have started only after all proper tools and tackles are supplied by the contractor and verified by UCIL Engineer-In-Charge or his representative. In case of any missing/broken or special tools are required the same shall be supplied by the Contractor as per UCIL direction. This shall be final and binding.
 - vii) The Bidder shall also supply Soldering Wire / bar, flux etc. as and when required for the rewinding job such that sufficient stock remains available with them at any point of time during the period of the contract. No extra claim shall be entertained.
 6. **Rate:** – The contractor shall fill all item rates inclusive of service cost, P.F., Bonus, EDLI, EPF Admin Charge, E.S.I., cost of safety appliances, PPE, tools and tackles and other miscellaneous overhead expenditures and applicable GST.
 7. **Payment terms:** - Max. 3 (Three) running account bills and final bill will be allowed. GST invoice with copy of GST payment challans and B2B shall be submitted along with bills.
 8. No escalation on any account whatsoever shall be paid against this work.

9. Contractor shall deliver scrap copper of burnt motors to our Central Stores, Turamdih.
10. **Quantity Variation:** $\pm 10\%$
11. **Time Extension:** In order to execute the extended/varied works up to $\pm 10\%$ as per Clause No. 10 above, necessary time may be extended / reduced suitably as the case may be by the Corporation on approval of the competent authority.
12. **Inspection:** The motor will be inspected during or after rewinding as and when required by Engineer-In-Charge or his representative.
13. **Validity of offer:** 60 days
14. If damages happen to the motor/s by the Contractor during the rewinding process, the same shall be assessed in the bills for payment.
15. The strong wooden formers for rewinding of motor of different sizes shall be supplied by the Contractor. These wooden formers shall be the property of UCIL after finishing of rewinding job or end of the contract period.
16. The Contractor shall pay to labour employed by him wages not less than fair wages as defined in the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970 and rules made there under.
17. The Contract shall in respect of labour employed by him comply with or cause to be complied with the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970 and Rules made there under in regard to all matters provided there in.
18. The Contractor shall comply with the provisions of the payment of Wages Act, 1936, Minimum Wages Act, 1946, Employers Liability Act, 1938, Workman's Compensation Act 1923, Industrial Disputes Act 1947, Maternity Benefit Act, 1961 and of any modifications thereof or any other Law relating thereof and rules made there under time to time. **The contractor shall arrange to provide P.F. and Bonus to his employees engaged for this job as per existing rate.**
19. During the entire validity period, on every working day the contractor's rewinders shall report to the Engineer-In-Charge or his representative for the urgent rewinding job to be carried out if any.
20. Copies of valid workmen insurance, medical fitness certificates duly certified, copies of I.D. proof (Voter I.D. etc.), 1 no. passport photo and copies of (Gate Pass issued by UCIL) for persons deployed for this job shall have to be submitted by the contractor on their expenses to the Engineer-in-charge or his representative before starting of the job.
21. The following registers and records shall be maintained under Minimum Wages Act/Payment of Wages Act and Contractors Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970 etc.
 - i) Muster Roll (Attendance Register)
 - ii) Register of wages
22. The contractor shall submit the following in addition to the copy of the documents as mentioned at Clause 21 above:
 - i) Bank statement showing payment of wages to employees
 - ii) Original challan/bills of materials supplied to UCIL
 - iii) P.F. and ESI statement
 - iv) Copy of ESI etc.
 - v) Any other document required such as Wage Slip etc.

23. Safety precautions should be strictly maintained during the execution of this work. All the safety appliances like helmet, safety goggles, gloves etc. required for this job should be provided to the workmen engaged by the Contractor at your own cost. The Contractor should also ensure that all the safety gadgets are used by the workmen at any cost. If any unsafe act is being found to be carried by Contractor's workmen, Contractor shall be held responsible and penalty may be imposed upon the Contractor for violation of safety regulations and norms.
24. Income tax will be deducted at source as per the rules.
25. **Goods and Services Tax (G.S.T.):** G.S.T. as per prevailing G.S.T. act and rules shall be applicable for this work. However, G.S.T. shall be paid extra only on submission of valid G.S.T. Payment challans and B2B to corporation along with the running bills.
26. All other terms and conditions like compensation for delay, termination of contract; arbitration clause etc. shall be governed as per the norms of the Corporation.
